**Subject: Terms & Conditions for Students Access to the Première Vision Paris physical event from 8 - 10 Feb 2022. Please read carefully.**

Dear Sir or Madam,

We kindly ask you to take note of the access conditions for the upcoming exhibition (physical event)

### **A) Access**

- 1) Passes are ordered on an individual basis, by connecting to your profile on [www.premierevision.com](http://www.premierevision.com). It is essential to specify the **category "College"** when activating your profile
- 2) Access to students and their teachers will be possible **on Wednesday 9 and Thursday 10 February**, Tuesday 8 being reserved for professionals.
- 3) Entrance to the physical event will be via halls 4, 5 and 6, on presentation of the **Health Pass** then the e-pass (both are QR codes) at the various control points, using a smartphone. There will no longer be a dedicated "COLLEGE" desk. If there are any problems when trying to enter the halls, a "help desk" present in each welcome area will be available for visitors from all categories.
- 4) Do not block the entrance and gather your students outside in order to enter as a group.
- 5) Each student **must carry their student card** and **MUST** be in the final year of the school curriculum (**last year of BA and MA**).
- 6) The number of students must not exceed 10% of the total number of visitors at the physical event.
- 7) Cloakrooms are not free (€4/article)

### **B) Rules to observe at the physical event**

#### **1. It is strictly forbidden to:**

- a) Make drawings of fabrics, bring scissors or cutters into the show, take or cut out fabric samples
- b) Access the booths which are privileged working areas reserved for professional visitors
- c) Take photos inside the show, whether of the general atmosphere, the stands or the forums
- d) **Picnic in the aisles:** rest areas and the outdoor space are provided for this purpose
- e) **Security:** According to the French Vigipirate security programme, handbags may be systematically searched. In order to simplify this procedure, please make sure that students do not bring large bags; any large bags must be left in the cloakrooms.

2. **Important:**

Do not forget to remind students that our exhibitions are professional trade shows and privileged places for Exhibitors and Buyers to get together.

Students have access to the presentations of the season's Fashion Information, the information points and Forums.

**In return, we ask them to show consideration towards our Exhibitors' working areas.**
