**Subject: Students Access Terms & Conditions for Première Vision Paris in-person event from 7 to 9 February 2023**

**To be read carefully**

Dear Sir or Madam,

We thank you to take note of the access conditions to the next exhibition (in-person event)

**A) Access**

- 1) Passes have to be ordered on an **individual basis**, each student/lecturer needs to create/log into his profile on [www.premierevision.com](http://www.premierevision.com), having specified the **“College” category** on the 1<sup>st</sup> page
- 2) Access to students and their teachers will be **possible on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> ir Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> February 2023**, Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> being reserved for professionals.
- 3) Entrance will be through halls 4, 5 or 6, presenting the e-pass (QR codes) at one of the various control points, using a smartphone.
- 4) For any problem when trying to enter the halls, a “help desk” in each welcome area will be available for visitors from all categories.
- 5) It is important not to block the entrance halls, as students are expected to remain outside or on the sides for grouped access.
- 6) Each student **must carry his student card** and **MUST** be in the final year of school curriculum. **(last year of BA, and MA)**
- 7) The number of students at the show must not exceed 10% of the visitors present at the show.
- 8) Cloakrooms are not free (4€/article)

**B) Rules to observe at the show**

**1. It is strictly forbidden to:**

- a) Make drawings of fabrics, bring scissors or cutters into the show, take or cut out fabrics samples
- b) Access the booths which are privileged working areas reserved to professional visitors
- c) Take photos inside the show, whether of the general atmosphere, the booths, the forums or of course the materials

- d) **Have a picnic in the aisles**
- e) **Security**: According to the Vigipirate plan, handbags might be systematically searched. In order to simplify this procedure, please make sure that students do not bring large bags; any large bags must be left in the cloakrooms.

## 2. **Important** :

We kindly remind students that our exhibitions are professional trade shows and privileged places for Exhibitors and Buyers to get together.

They have access to the season's Fashion Information presented, to the information points and Forums.

**We ask each student in return to show consideration for our Exhibitors' working areas.**
